**EASTERN PANHANDLE HOME CONSORTIUM OF WEST VIRGINIA  
Funding Application Information FY 2010**

The City of Martinsburg, as the lead jurisdiction for the Eastern Panhandle HOME Consortium of West Virginia (EPHC), invites interested organizations to submit funding proposals for the use of HOME Investment Partnership Program funds for FY 2009 (July 1, 2010 – June 30, 2011).

**Projects must be eligible under the HOME Investment Partnerships Program (24 CFR Part 92). Proposals are accepted on an open basis. Applicants are encouraged to contact the HOME Administrator to discuss their proposal and the HOME requirement, prior to submitting their proposal.**

The HOME Consortium's funding allocation from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development is not known at this time. The FY 2009 allocation was \$519,967. HOME funds for FY 2009 and member allocations are: below:
